


HOW TO CLEAN AND PROTECT ELECTRIC HOTPLATES

For this maintenance project, you will need:

- ✓ A sponge
- √ Hotplate protectant
- ✓ Microfibre cloth
- 1. First, ensure the stove top is turned off, and cool.
- 2. Using a nylon sponge, scrub off any dirt, rust, or food residue before wiping clean.
- 3. Apply hotplate protectant, following the instructions from the manufacturer.
- 4. Once a thin, even coating has been applied, use a clean microfibre cloth to buff off the excess.
- 5. Turn on the hotplate, allowing it to heat up until any residue has burnt off.
- 6. Repeat with remaining hotplates.



Ensure the stovetop is turned off and cool!
